# 1. The Bible Asks Us to Remember

**Remember** how the LORD your God led you all the way in the desert these forty years, to humble you and to test you in order to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep his commands -

**Deuteronomy 8:2**

- **I remember** the days of long ago; **I meditate** on all your works and **consider** what your hands have done. **Psalm 143:3-5**
- **Remember** the former things, those of long ago; I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me. **Isaiah 46:9**

- **“Remember** the words I spoke to you...”  
**John 15:20**
- Therefore, **remember** that formerly you who are Gentiles by birth ... <sup>12</sup> **remember** that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. **Epehesians 2:11-13**

## **2. The Benefits of Remember**

# Thankful Heart

# Strenght and Hope

- Has his unfailing love vanished forever? Has his promise failed for all time? <sup>9</sup> Has God forgotten to be merciful? Has he in anger withheld his compassion?" **Psalm 77:8 -9**

## Deuteronomy 8: 12- 18

- For when you have become **full and prosperous** and have built fine homes to live in, <sup>13</sup> and when your flocks and herds have become very large and your silver and gold have multiplied along with everything else, be careful! <sup>14</sup> **Do not become proud** at that time and **forget the LORD your God**, who rescued you from slavery in the land of Egypt. <sup>15</sup> **Do not forget** that he led you through the great and terrifying wilderness with its poisonous snakes and scorpions, where it was so hot and dry. He gave you water from the rock!

**16 He fed you with manna in the wilderness, a food unknown to your ancestors. He did this to humble you and test you for your own good. 17 He did all this so you would never say to yourself, 'I have achieved this wealth with my own strength and energy.' 18 Remember the LORD your God. He is the one who gives you power to be successful, in order to fulfill the covenant he confirmed to your ancestors with an oath.**



- Therefore, **remember** that formerly you who are Gentiles by birth and called "uncircumcised" by those who call themselves "the circumcision" (that done in the body by the hands of men)-- <sup>12</sup> **remember** that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ. **Ephesians 2:11-13**

**But because of his great love for us,  
God, who is rich in mercy, <sup>5</sup> made us  
alive with Christ even when we  
were dead in transgressions-- it is by  
grace you have been saved.**

**Ephesians 2:4-5**

# Repentance

- **Remember** the wonders he has done, his miracles, and the judgments he pronounced,-  
**Psalm 105:5**
- **Remember** this and never forget how you provoked the LORD your God to anger in the desert. From the day you left Egypt until you arrived here, you have been rebellious against the LORD. **Deuteronomy 9:7**

**Remember** the height from which you have fallen! **Repent** and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place. **Revelation 2:5**
